Hike through the Laikipia Plateau of Kenya's Great Rift Valley to benefit the 1800+ orphans of Makindu Children's Centre.

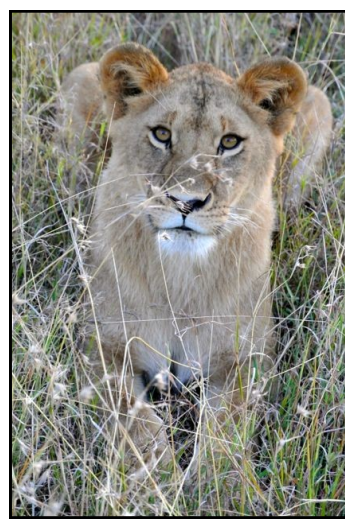
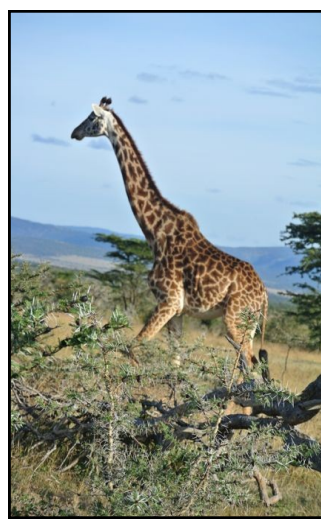
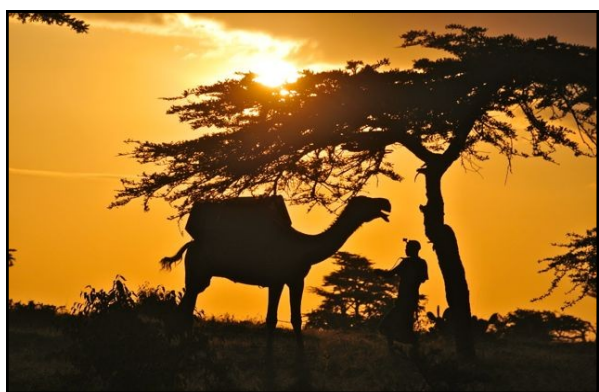
The hike will take you through 120 miles of rugged wilderness teeming with wildlife.
